### Expert, convenient wound care at home

If you have had an accident resulting in a wound that needs medical attention, you may not have to wait to see your GP.

### Contact us direct if:

- Your wound is the result of an accident and
- \* You can't get a timely GP appointment or it is physically challenging to get to your GP clinic e.g. mobility issues, transport challenges

Our specialist nurses are contracted by ACC to provide wound care services in your home.

Services are **free** if your treatment is covered by ACC. If you are not eligible for ACC cover, we can offer private or co-payment options.

### Wound care:

- With your consent, we can keep your GP team updated as necessary
